Dear Dr. See,

I am directing this correspondence to you at the request of Mr. Maurice Washington, with whom I spoke with yesterday, and who requested the Nevada State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) prepare a letter outlining the legal parameters of a medical doctor obtaining restricted medical licensure in the state of Nevada pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 630.2645.

NRS 630.2645 allows a restricted medical license to be issued to an applicant who: 1) is a graduate of a foreign medical school; 2) teaches, researches or practices medicine outside the United States; 3) is a recognized medical expert; and 4) intends to teach, research or practice clinical medicine at a medical research facility or medical school in the state of Nevada.

A person who is issued a restricted medical license under NRS 630.2645 may only practice medicine in the state of Nevada within the limitations and restrictions established by the Board. Additionally, if a person who holds a restricted medical license issued pursuant to NRS 630.2645 ceases to teach, research or practice clinical medicine at a medical research facility or medical school where the person is employed, the medical research facility or medical school is obligated to notify the Board of the same, and upon receipt of such notification, the restricted license expires automatically.

It is my understanding that you have recruited, or are in the process of recruiting, one or more individuals who may seek restricted medical licensure in the state of Nevada under NRS 630.2645; the Board welcomes those applicants who would meet the threshold requirements noted above, but I would note that the limitations and restrictions of an applicant's medical practice is a matter that would have to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

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
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I hope this correspondence satisfies your request, and please advise me if I can be of any further assistance in this regard.
